Tema vir die Maand

In Skakel

Die woord "skakel" ("link" in Engels) vind sy oorsprong in die ou Germaanse taal. Die betekenis daarvan verwys na 'n *ring* – 'n onbreekbare verbintenis – of enigets wat dien om een deel of ding met 'n ander te verbind. Met tyd, gebeure en ontwikkeling, het die woord ook ontwikkel om ons wêreld te verwoord. Vandag is die konsep van 'n enkele skakel byna vreemd, tog verstaan ons die waarde van 'n enkele skakel wat ingeskakel is in 'n langer ketting. So is ons goed bekend met die gesegde: "*n Ketting is net so sterk soos sy swakste skakel*".

Die belangrikheid van elke enkele *skakel* om "iets" in te bind, is sigbaar in soveel fasette van ons lewens. 'n Sterk skakel verbind een saak met 'n ander sonder 'n vrees van skeiding. 'n Sterk ketting word gebruik om iets vas te maak met sekerheid. 'n Gesonde skakel verskaf 'n spasie waarin iets of iemand tuiskom.

Tog is elke skakel deel van 'n groter prentjie. In die moderne rekenaar gedreve era is digitale verbindings tussen webblaaie, om skakels op of na 'n webbladsy of elektroniese dokument te hê 'n groot dryfkrag ter wille van verbintenis. So is ons almal bekend met die idee van "Ses grade van skeiding" – die idee dat alle mense ses of minder sosiale verbindings van mekaar af is. Gevolglik kan 'n ketting "vriend van 'n vriend"-stellings gemaak word om enige twee mense in 'n maksimum van ses stappe te verbind.

Die skepping, volgens Genesis, gebeur ook in ses dae wat bymekaar inskakel deurdat God sistematies en ge-orden die aarde geskep het. Alles in die skepping is in 'n balans met mekaar ingeskakel. Elke skakel met 'n besondere doel en waarde, in-geskakel met die volgende skakel om 'n lewens-ketting te vorm waarin skakels mekaar versterk en waarde bied.


