Resep van die Maand

Jan Ellis-poeding

(Hierdie maand se resep is 'n familie resep wat al vir jare hul familie gunsteling is.)

Deeg:

- 5 ml koeksoda
- 125 ml melk
- 200 g (375 ml) bruismeel
- 100 g (125 ml) witsuiker
- 2 eiers
- 30 ml fyn appelkooskonfyt
- 20 g (25 ml) baie sagte botter / margarien
- 1 ml sout

Sous:

- 250 ml water
- 250 ml room
- 230 g (250 ml) botter/ margarien
- 200 g (250 ml) witsuiker
- 5 ml vanieljegeursel

Metode:

- Voorverhit die oond tot 180 grade C.
- Bespuit 'n oondvaste poedingbak met 'n volume van 2 l.
- Los die koeksoda in die melk op.
- Meng die res van die deeg se bestandele.
- Roer die sodamelk by en meng baie goed.
- Skep die deeg in die bak en bak dit 25-30 minute lank.
- (Moenie 'n kleiner bak gebruik nie, al lyk die deeg 'n bietjie min vir die bak.)

Sous:

- Verhit al die bestandele vir die sous saam tot kookpunt.
- Gooi die warm sous bietjies gewys oor die warm poeding sodra dit uit die oond kom.
- Laat die poeding 'n rukkie staan sodat die sous kan intrek.
- Sit dit loutwarm voor met dun vla of roomys.

Top 10 braai rules

(according to Jan Braai in the South African)

1. Nothing beats a real wood fire.
2. 'GAS' is Afrikaans for a guest at your braai, not something you braai with.
3. 'BRAAIING' is the only fat- negative way of cooking food. Even when you steam food, the fat in it stays behind. When you braai, the fat drips out. Be healthy and braai.
4. Whereas steak is served medium rare and pork is served medium, lamb is served pink not quite medium rare or medium, a tricky ask. You need to have the thickest part of it at 63 degrees celsius, then it is perfect.
5. 'Braaiing' is a direct form of energy use, from the coals to your meat. With conventional electricity, there is a lot of spillage between the power plant, power lines, electricity box, wires, stove and pan. If you love the earth, braai.
6. Have enough ice at your braai. Use it for your brandy and coke, to make beers cold and to treat burn wounds.

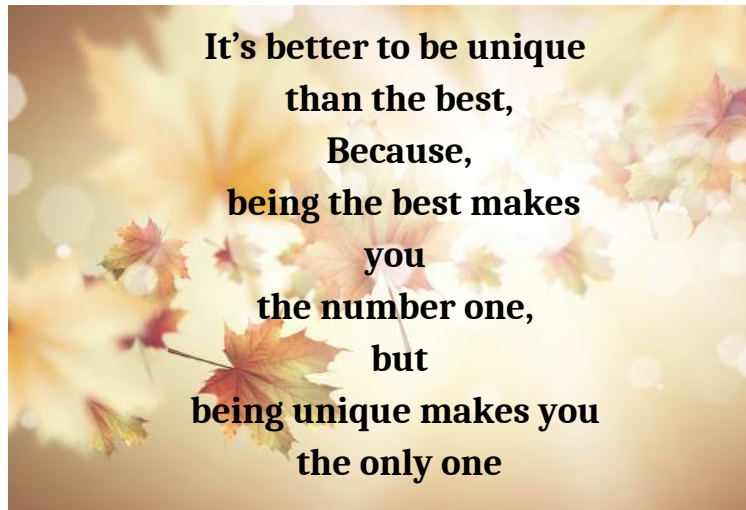
