Maandelikse Bybel Bespreking Nuuskierig en Nuus-keurig

Afrikaans sê so mooi: 'van nuuskierigheid is die kerke leeg en die tronke vol'. Dit is in die mens se natuur om nuuskierig te wees en ondersoek in te stel. Baie gelowiges meen nuuskierigheid is 'n Goddelike gawe wat ons dryf om te verken, te leer en te groei. In Spreuke 25:2 staan daar: *"Dit is die eer van God om 'n saak te verberg, maar die eer van konings is om 'n saak te ondersoek."* Hierdie Skrif moedig ons aan om kennis en begrip te soek, wat uiteindelik God se beeld as die Skepper en Kenner van almal en alles sal weerspieël.

Te midde van die groot "cloud" van inligting wat vandag beskikbaar is, is dit deurslaggewend om onderskeid te kan tref tussen die kaf en die koring. Spreuke 4:23 beveel aan: *"Bewaak jou hart meer as alles wat bewaar moet word, want alles wat jy doen vloeи daaruit voort."* Dit vereis 'n noukeurige keuse van wat ons toelaat om ons gedagtes en harte te beïnvloed. Nie alle inligting is opbouend of waar nie; sommige kan ons op 'n dwaalspoor lei of verwarring saai.

Om ons nuuskierigheid te balanseer met onderskeidingsvermoë behels gebed en die leiding van die Heilige Gees. Jakobus 1:5 belowe: *"As een van julle wysheid kortkom, moet hy dit van God bid, en Hy sal dit aan hom gee, want God gee aan almal sonder voorbehoud en sonder verwyt."* In oorleg met God, kan ons deur die oorvloed van kennis en nuus navigeer, om gevolglik noukeurig te kan kies met 'n hart wat na waarheid en groei in Christus soek.

Hierdie sinergie en balans, tussen nuuskierigheid en noukeurige keuse, verseker dat ons strewe na kennis ons nader aan God lei, en ons lewensreis sal groei tot 'n Geestelike volwassenheid en 'n dieper begrip van Sy skepping. So groei ons in wysheid en geloof, en word meer effektiewe dissipels.






Resep van die Maand

Pecan Toffee Cake

Ingredients

300g pecan halves
150g stoneless dates
200g butter, softened, plus extra for greasing
200g muscovado sugar
1 tsp mixed spice
4 eggs, beaten
150g self raising flour
Maple syrup, to serve
Vanilla ice- cream, to serve

Method:



1. Put 100g pecans into a processor and whizz until fine- and tip into a bowl. (If you haven't got a processor, place the nuts in a plastic bag, put a tea towel over the top and gently bash them with a rolling pin until finely broken up.) Put the dates into a small pan with enough water to cover and boil for five minutes until very soft. Drain, discarding the liquid, then whizz in the processor until smooth. Or alternatively, chop finely. Leave to cool.
2. Heat oven to 180 degrees C/ fan 160. Butter and line the base of a 23cm cake tin. Beat the butter, sugar and spice together until light and creamy, then tip in the dates, ground pecans, eggs and a pinch of salt. Beat briefly until smooth.
3. Fold in the flour with a metal spoon, then spoon into the tin and level the top. Sprinkle the remaining nuts over the top (don't press them in), then bake for 40 minutes or until risen and golden and a skewer comes out clean. Serve warm, with generous drizzles of maple syrup and scoops of vanilla ice-cream.

Dandelion

"The dandelion is the only flower that represents the three celestial bodies of the sun, moon, and stars":

The yellow flower resembles the sun, the puff ball resembles the moon, and the dispersing seeds resemble the stars.

The dandelion flower opens to greet the morning and closes in the evening to go to sleep.

Every part of the dandelion is useful: root, leaves, flower. It can be used for food, medicine, and dye for colouring.

Up until the 1800s, people would pull grass out of their lawns to make room for dandelions and other useful "weeds" like chickweed, malva and chamomile.

The name dandelion is taken from the French word "dent de lion" meaning lion's tooth, referring to the coarsely-toothed leaves.

Dandelions have one of the longest flowering seasons of any plant.

Dandelion seeds are often transported away by a gust of wind and they travel like tiny parachutes.

Seeds are often carried as many as five miles from their origin!

Birds, insects, and butterflies consume nectar or seeds of dandelion.

Honey from bees pollinating dandelions is quite delicious.

Dandelion flowers do not need to be pollinated to form seeds.

Root of dandelion can be used as a substitute for coffee.

Dandelion is used in folk medicine to treat infections and liver disorders.

Tea made of dandelion act as a diuretic.

If you know dandelions, they'll grow shorter stalks to spite you.

Dandelions are, quite possibly, the most successful plants that exist.

They are masters of survival worldwide."
